

## **Directions to Camp Cachalot**

Many GPSes and online maps will send you down unpaved roads or roads with locked gates if using their directions to find Camp Cachalot. It is often safer to get directions to the headquarters of Myles Standish State Forest, then follow the signs in the forest to get to Cachalot itself.

*From points South and West, including the New Bedford/Fall River area:*

- Follow Route 195E onto Route 495N
- Continue on Route 495N to Exit 2 (Route 58), and follow Route 58N off the exit.
- Follow directions from 495/58 Junction, below

*From points North and West, including the Taunton area and Boston:*

- Take Route 495S to Exit 2 (Route 58), and follow Route 58N off the exit.
- Follow directions from 495/58 Junction, below

*From points East including Cape Cod:*

- Follow Route 25M until it becomes Route 495N
- Continue on Route 495N to Exit 2 (Route 58), and follow Route 58N off the exit.
- Follow directions from 495/58 Junction, below

*From the 495/58 Junction:*

- When Route 58 turns left, continue straight (remain on Tremont Street)
- Turn right onto Cranberry Road
- At Myles Standish State Forest headquarters, turn left onto Lower College Pond Road (from here the forest signage is good and can be followed)
- Continue onto Halfway Pond Road
- Turn right onto Upper College Pond Road
- Turn left onto Fearing Pond Road
- Pass the turn for Charge Pond (stay left)
- Turn right onto SE Line Road (sign for Camp Cachalot)
- Follow the paved road to the camp's sign and gate, then continue along the gravel road into the camp.
- Parking is available next to the Boathouse, with overflow by the maintenance yard

The map below shows the route from Cranberry Road on the left to the camp. Note the sharp turns at forest headquarters, onto Upper College Pond Road, and Fearing Pond Road.
